TWO TERRACES VINEYARD Chenin Blanc

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

A warm spring catalysed an early bud burst. Sporadic rainfall coupled with warmer than average temperatures set a moderate crop through spring and early summer. From midsummer, warm dry conditions persisted through until harvest yielding fully ripe, concentrated fruit in impeccable condition.

THE VINEYARD

Two Terraces Vineyard, located in Maraekakaho district of Hawke's Bay.

Soil Deep Red Gravels

Clone/Rootstock 40% 220, 60% 880 on 3309 rootstock

Viticulture 3030vines/ha, Cane pruned, Vertically shoot positioned

THE HARVEST Hand Picked on the 21s March

Average Brix 22.8 brix

Yield 8tonnes/ha or 56HL/ha

IN THE WINERY

Fermentation 100% whole bunch pressed, cloudy juice run straight to

combination of concrete egg and used French Oak barriques.

Post Ferment Left on yeast lees. Partial spring malolactic ferment.

Maturation 6 months in 80% Cast Stone concrete egg, 20% in used French

oak barriques

Finishing No fining, fine pad filtration, bottled on site.

Note Our wines are not cold or heat stabilised, and therefore may

form harmless sediment in bottle.




THE WINE

Tasting Note: This allowed full ripeness yielding a wine with more stone fruit characters, lots of palate weight and length of flavour, yet still given tension via mineral notes and natural acid frame.
